Objectives	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - refresh and broaden one's command of French - improve oral skills to feel more confident - make integration easier with ESA students - become acquainted with the local environment (everyday life around the college and city) - Methodological tools for written and oral skills (group A) 						
Contents	<p>This intensive session will alternate classes focusing on language skills (an average of two classes a day with two different lecturers), thematic classes in French (« Vivre en France », « Découverte de l'Anjou viticole »..), cultural visits (Angers, Saumur, countryside around Angers) and technical visits (visit to cellars...). Finally, some personal work (individual and group work) will be requested in addition to classes.</p>						
Prerequisites	Please note that these courses are not aimed at beginners but rather at students with an elementary or intermediate level of French, who lack confidence and have difficulties speaking, or at students with an advanced level and wishing to acquire methodological tools.						
Teaching methods	<p>Students are divided into three different groups:</p> <p>A: advanced B: intermediate C: elementary</p>						
Assessment	<p>The attendance of the French session accounts for 4 ECTS credits (European Credit Transfer System), divided up as follows:</p> <p>Attendance = 0,5 Personal work / written work submitted = 0,5 Audio comprehension : 1 Final oral exam = 2</p>

Assessment	<p>The attendance of this module accounts for 2 ECTS credits (European Credit Transfer System), divided up as follows: Attendance/Classe participation: 1 Exam: 1</p> <p>One 2 hour written exam and a 15-min oral exam will take place at the end of the course (mid-December 2008).</p> <p>OPTIONAL: Preparing for the "TFI" (<i>Test de Français International</i>) For those students interested in the TFI, the exam will take place at ESA on December 4th. Four 1,5 hour preparation classes will be taught before the exam.</p>

Teaching methods	<p>Students are divided into two groups :</p> <p>Group 1 (for the students present at ESA since September) : classes focusing on methodological tools</p> <p>Group 2 (newcomers) : classes focusing on language skills</p> <p>The two groups attend one 2-hour class a week for a total of 22 hours + Exams</p>						
Assessment	<p>The attendance of this course accounts for 2 ECTS credits (European Credit Transfer System), divided up as follows: Attendance/ Class participation: 0,5 Exam: 1,5</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - One 2-hour written exam and one 15-mn oral exam will take place at the end of the course (beginning of May 2009) <p>OPTIONAL: Preparing for "TFI" (<i>Test de Français International</i>). For those students interested in the TFI, the exam will take place at ESA on May 14th. Four 1,5 hour preparation classes will be taught before the exam.</p>
